TEACHERS DAY CELEBRATION

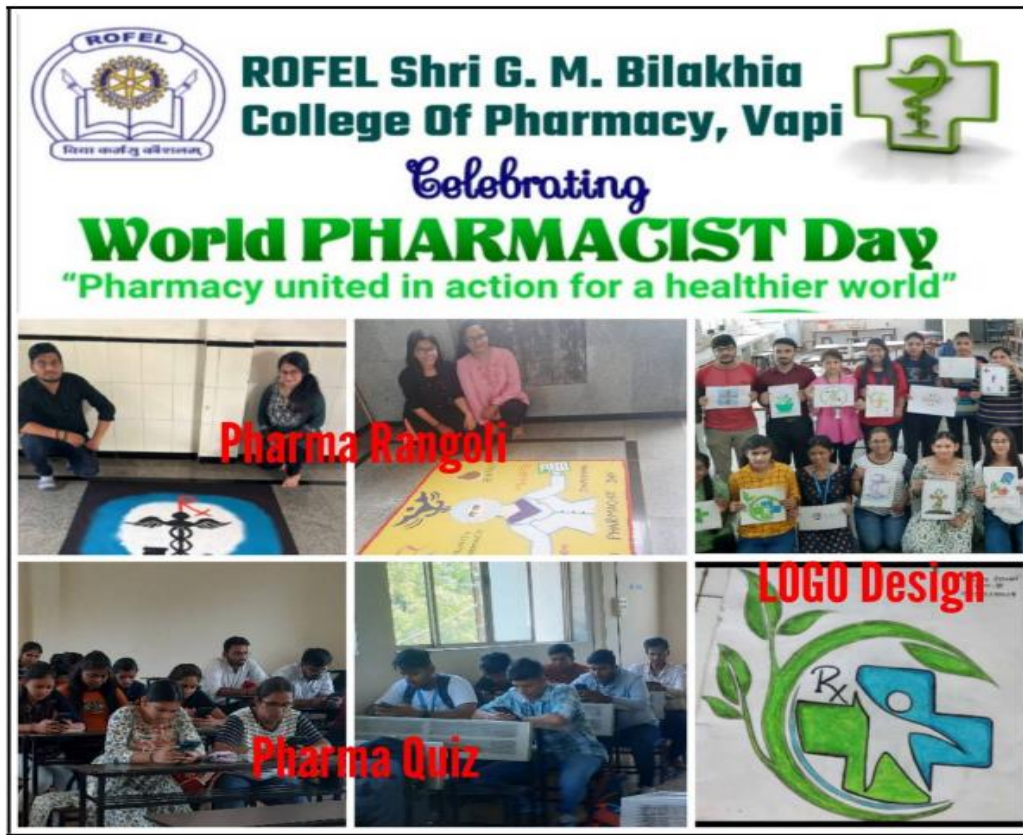

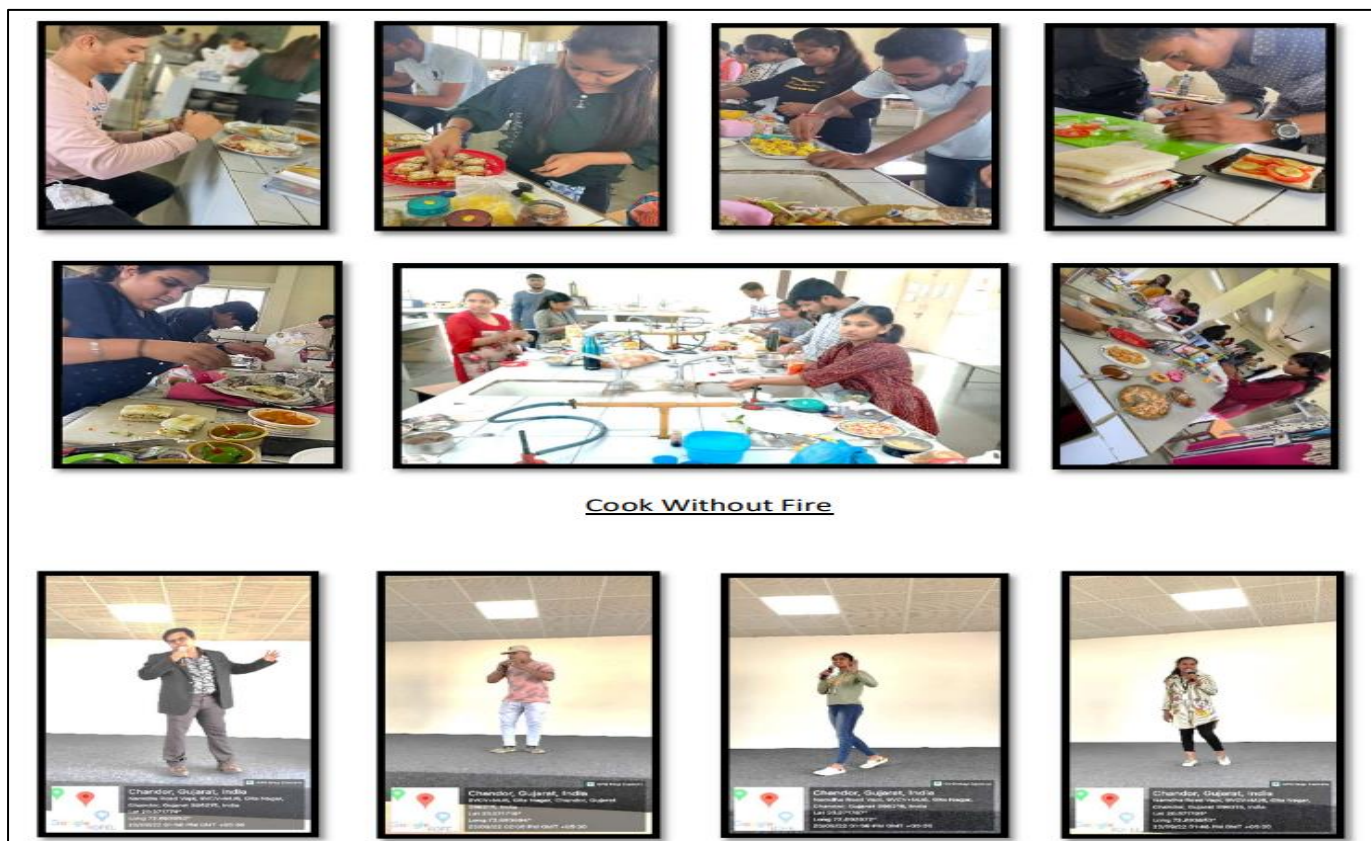
WORLD PHARMACIST DAY CELEBRATION

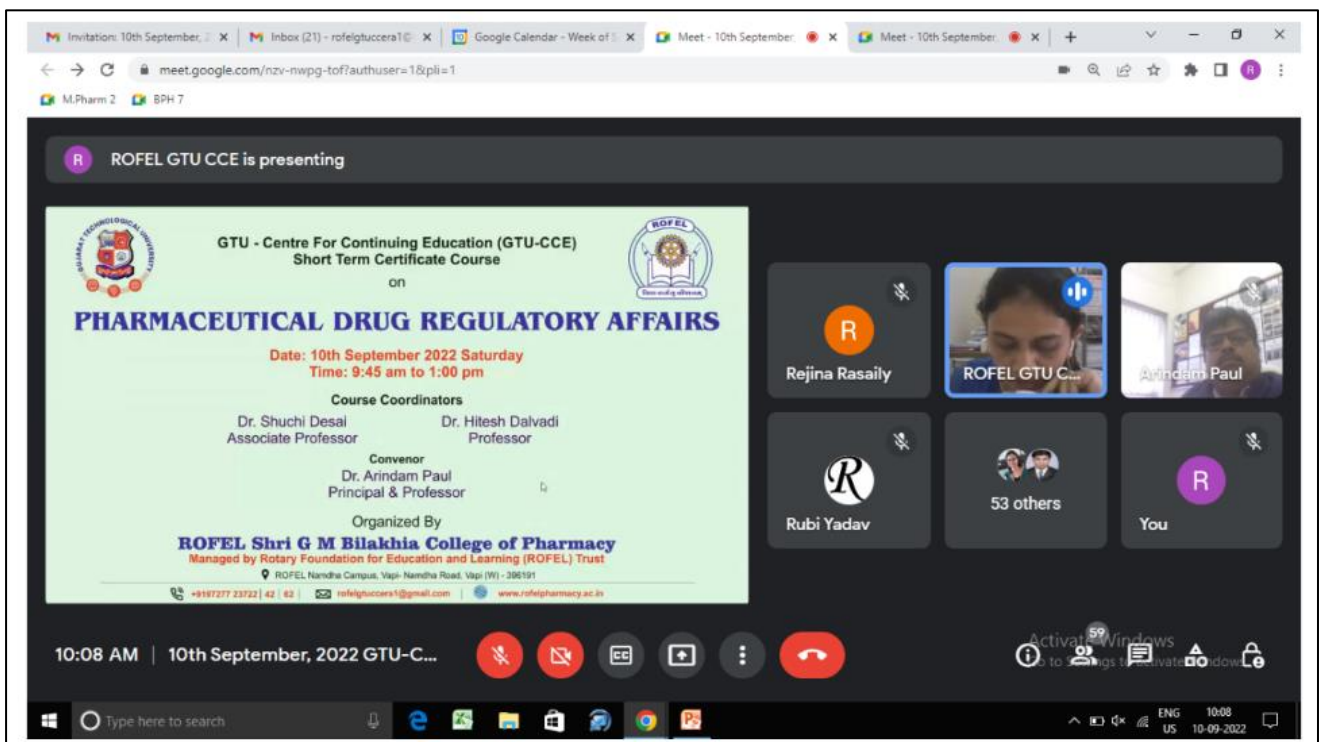

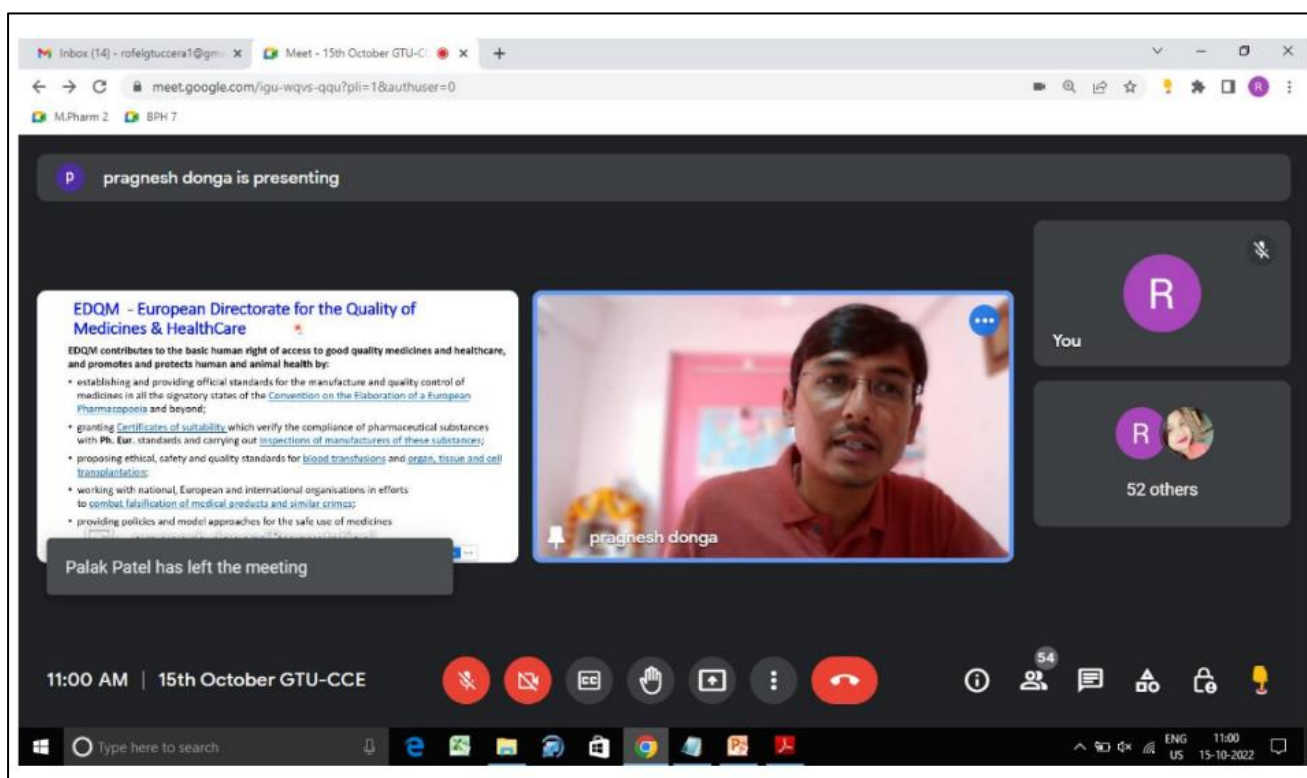
