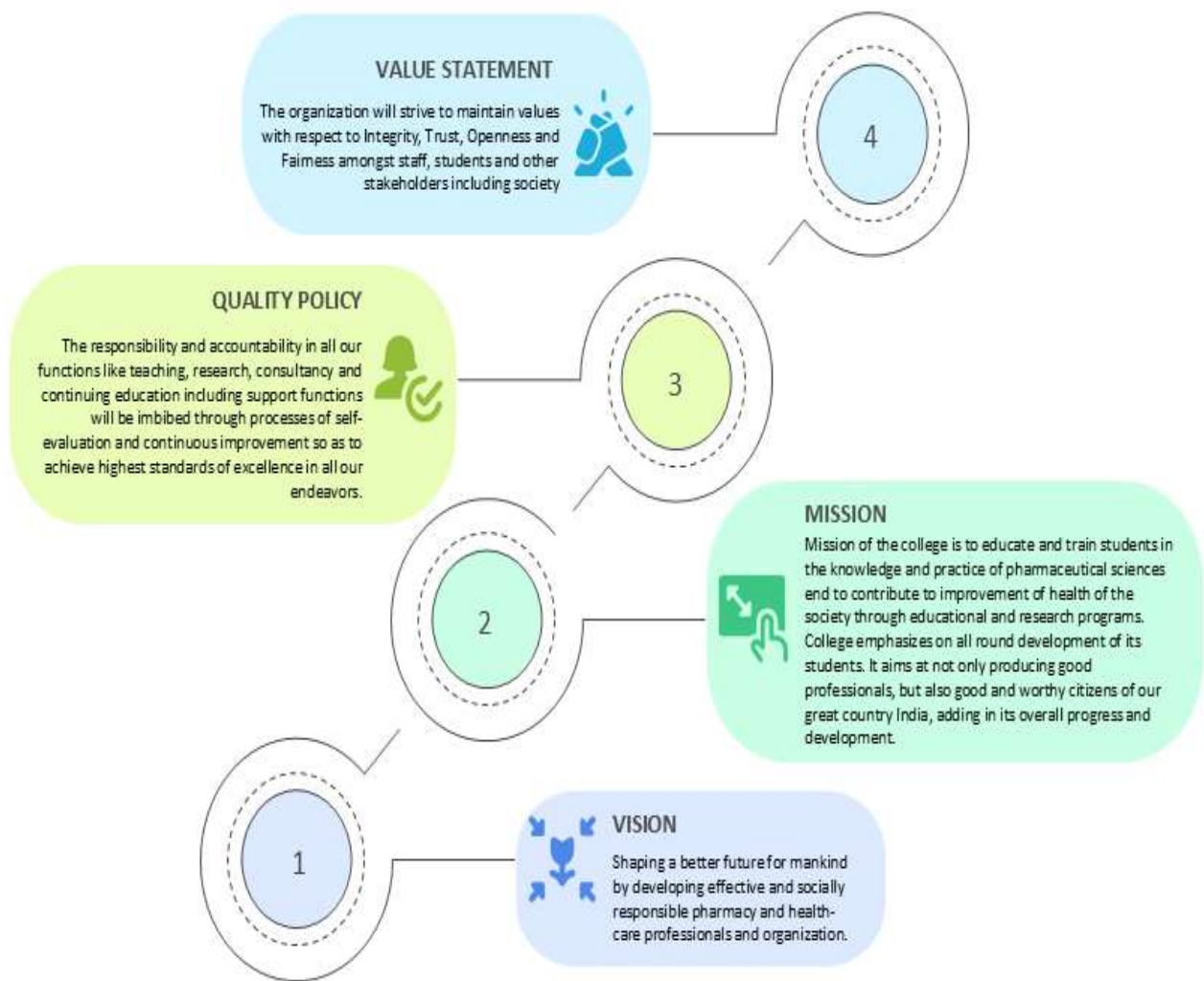

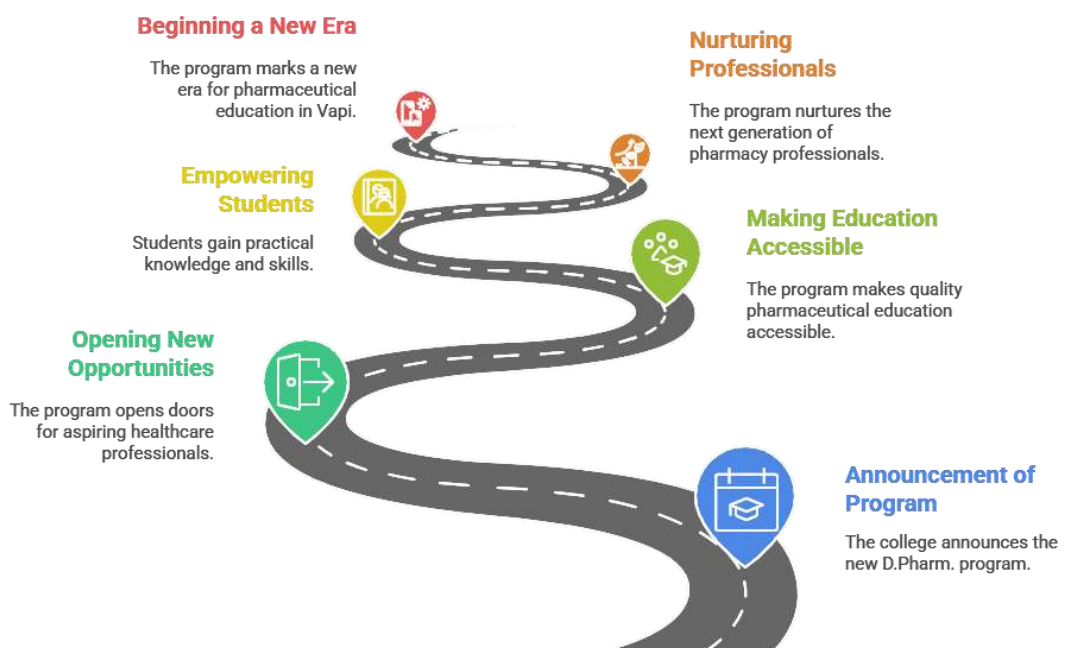

SCIENTIFIC ACTIVITIES

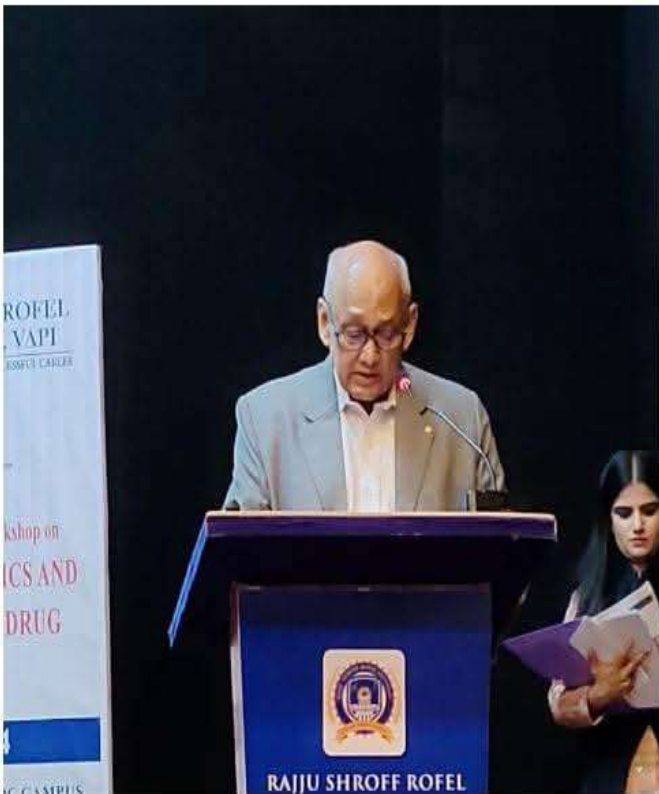

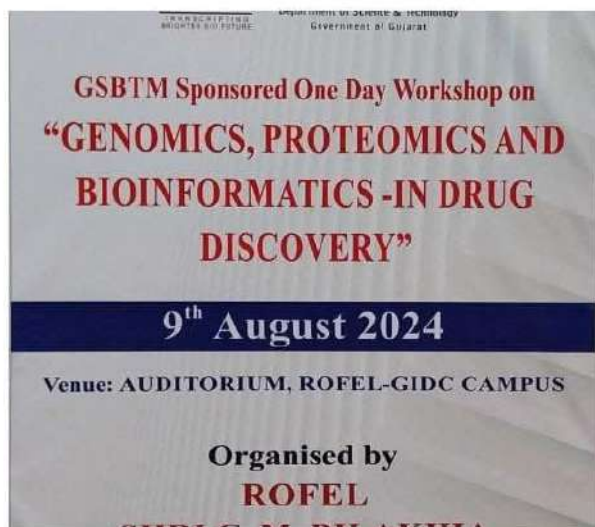
Workshop on Genomics, Proteomics and Bioinformatics in Drug Discovery – 9th August, 2024

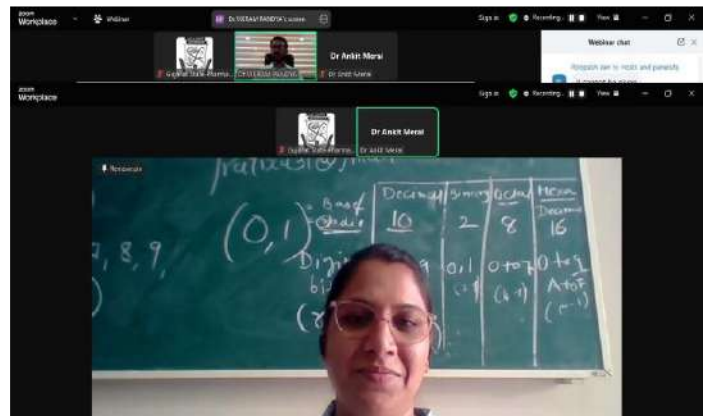
Health Talk on Adolescent Health & Infertility Concerns – 4th October, 2024
