A GUIDANCE SESSION FOR GPAT-2022

On February 11, 2022; a Guidance session for GPAT-2022 was organized for 3rd and 4th year B.pharm students. Session was held in online mode with a view of COVID guidelines laid by Health ministry of India. Programme was addressed by three subject experts who threw light on important topics of each pharmacy subject and strategy to crack the examination.

Mr. G. Santhana Kumar, Assistant Professor initiated the session by explaining the different logical and strategical techniques while answering the GPAT paper like the method of elimination, selection of option based on natural/ basic instinct. Then he explained the nature of MCQs in pharmacognosy and pharmacology. He also advised the students that the clearance of basic concepts of all the subjects of Pharmacy is essential for the Examination.

Dr. Komal Parmar, Associate Professor continued the session by explaining about continuous study along with revision of various subject which is necessary to achieve the success in GPAT Competitive exam. She also advised to the students that the clearance of basic concepts of all the subjects of Pharmacy is essential for the Examination. She also highlighted the various opportunities in Government, private as well as corporate sections in the field of Pharmacy. She explained the concepts of biopharmaceutics, bioequivalence studies, various aseptic areas in parenterals and their norms, HEPA and Laminar flow techniques. She also highlighted various cosmetic products with suitable examples. She explained various PG courses like M. Pharm, M.Tech, M.S, available in Indian and Foreign Universities. She also explained the nature of Competitive Examinations in Pharmacy like GPAT and NIPER.

Ms. Bijal Patel, Assistant Professor explained various techniques to remember the structures of drugs and heterocyclic compounds. Then she explained classification of various category of drugs, SAR, their mechanism of action and relevant examples. She also explained about frequently asked question in pharmaceutical chemistry and their explanation with answer.

At the end of session, students faced GPAT Mock test containing 50 Questions for duration of one hour. Test was conducted online using google forms and after test completion their respective score was released.
