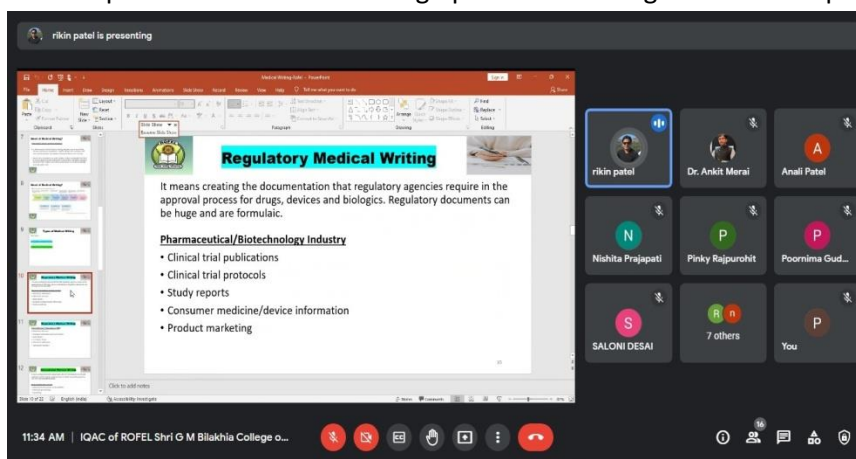
Title of Guest Lecture (Webinar): Medical writing in Clinical research

Speaker: Mr. Rikin Patel, Project manager, Veeda Clinical research, Ahmedabad.

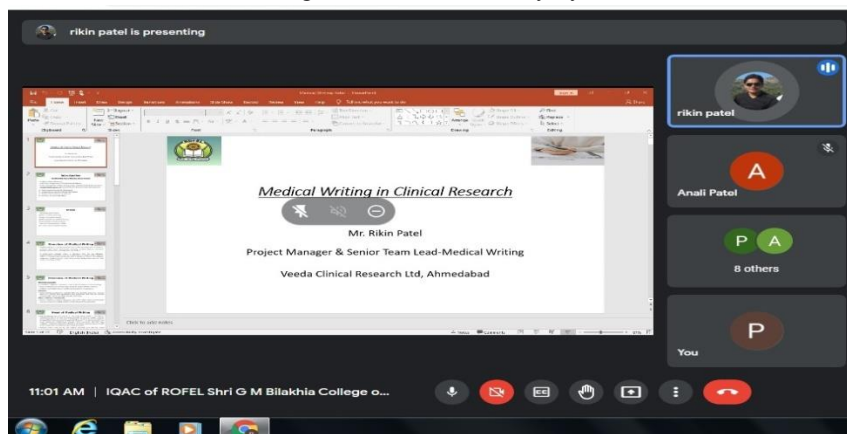
