REPORT OF GUEST/ EXTENSION LECTURE

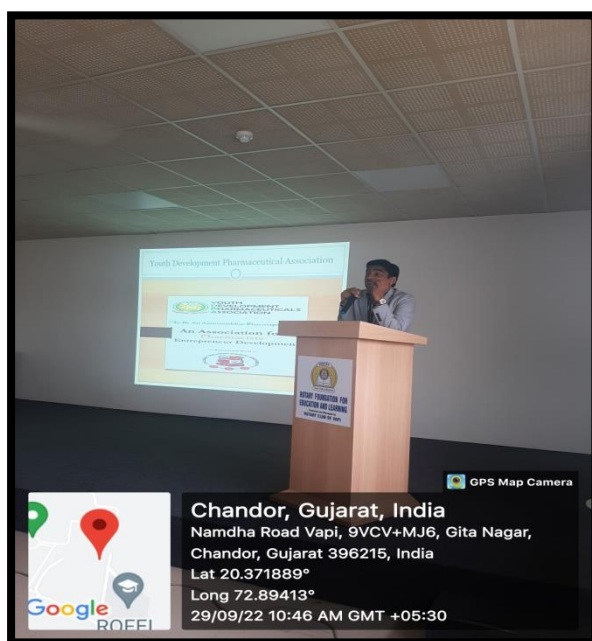
Title of Guest Lecture (Workshop): Entrepreneurship training Programme

Speaker: Mr. Nitin Raval, MD and Chairman, Youth Development Pharmaceutical Association

Summary Report: The workshop was organized to train the students on various aspects of entrepreneurship development which would motivate them to take up entrepreneurial activities after their graduation. The resource persons Mr. Nitin Raval, MD and Chairman, Youth Development Pharmaceutical Association, Ahmedabad, explained the creation of new goods and services and how they improve the quality of living of companies and individuals. Entrepreneurs acquire capital from their equity sources or loans from banks to build their business which adds value to the creation of wealth, influencing the economy and industrial structure of a country directly. In his sessions he motivated the students to take up their own start-ups. Mr. Nitin explained the importance of idea generation by the students, and how it enables the students to expand their range of ideas beyond current range of thinking, and she told that how thinking results in questions, more variables, and more ideas before beginning of any start-ups. Final year B Pharm and M Pharm students were present during the session. Mr Raval also explored detail information about YDPA and how it will help students in training and development for entrepreneurship.
